HARBOUR FACILITIES:

- ❖ River Harbour / North Quay, 5m draft, up to 90m length. Reputation for fast ship / cargo handling.
- ❖ 1360m quay frontage, North Quay floodlit.
- ❖ Large on and off-quay open storage available.
- ❖ 200 tonne Slipway facility currently unavailable.
- ❖ Bunkering by tanker from on-site tank farm.
- ❖ Water on all quays - max 50 tonne / hour.
- ❖ Weighbridge facility on site.
- ❖ Fathoms Ltd diving base on site.
- ❖ HGV transport, cranes, plant & skip hire on site.
