POSITION **LAT** **58° 26.5 'N**
LONG **03° 0.5 ' W** (**chart No 1462**)

LOCATION **on the East Caithness Coast**

South Pier Head, flashing Green / White / Red sectors every 3 sec, Green 253 to 269, White 269 to 286, Red 286 to 329 Transit marks to aid navigation to Outer harbour. Rear alongside north edge of fuel tanks on Commercial Quay, orange triangle, apex pointing down. Front mark located at southern end of South River Pier, Orange triangle, Apex pointing upwards. Course 285°T when aligned.

Leading lights into outer Harbour, two fixed red lights near root end of South Pier, not visible until entrance is opened. (Chart 1462 refers)

Beatrice Offshore Windfarm has set up an O&M Base within the confines of Wick Harbour. Three sets of Pontoons, to service 6 vessels, have been constructed to the West end of the Inner Harbour North Pier and should not be used by any other vessels.

PORT CLOSED SIGNAL **A black ball hoisted by day or green light by night on a building at the South Head, when Harbour is closed to all traffic.**

PLUS VAT AT 20%

Leisure vessels are charged 'per metre', based on the overall length of the vessel. Periods afloat and ashore can start and finish at any time throughout the year as required.

Tables 1 and 2 - serviced and unserviced marina berths, subject to a 5m min length charge.

Table 3 - metreage rate for Visiting Training Vessels.

Tables 1 & 2 show the onshore storage on WHA land, subject to a 5m min. length charge.

These rates will also apply to vessels engaged in commercial leisure activities, with a discounted passenger surcharge.

On-berth 'reasonable' water consumption is free.

Electricity will be charged as follows:-

- a) Resident berth holders at current WHA resale rate for long term use. Consult Office.
- b) Visitors at £1.67 + VAT per 24 hours (may apply)
- c) Owners to supply their own hoses and cables (all water at consumer's risk, cables to be PAT tested)

Toilets and showers available (keys from Office) Shower operated £1 coin meter.

Toilet keys to be returned before departure. Non-returns will be charged £5 + VAT

Regular commercial leisure trips will be charged 80p + VAT per passenger.

WHA strongly recommend that all leisure vessels berthed in the Harbour should carry at least Third Party Insurance cover to the value of £2,000,000.

Prices per metre will be calculated on the overall length of the boat, including davits, bowsprits, boarding ladders, stern drives, tenders, outdrives, anchors, pulpits and pushpits and any other extensions fore and aft of the vessel. Each vessel will be measured to verify actual overall length. Onshore storage on WHA property will be subject to availability.

If, after six months storage ashore, a vessel is not launched to any berth in the Harbour, the storage charge will double.

Empty trailers, masts and cradles stored on WHA property will be charged at £8.33 + VAT(£10.00) per month
